It was in the late 1980's that the author devised and promoted the Itchen Way long-distance footpath. It has received financial support from Hampshire County Council, Eastleigh Borough Council and Eastleigh Ramblers towards the cost of the waymarks. Three thousand copies of "Exploring the Itchen Way" (published in 1990 ISBN 1-85306-083-6) were sold. This first book suggested walking it in a series of circular walks taking in some of the surrounding countryside.

A 2008 second book was for those wishing to do the long-distance walk as a linear path.

This latest 56-page third full colour guide book is an updated version but now includes extracts from the 1:25,000 Ordnance Survey Sheets and all you need to undertake the walk.
